Curriculum Overview

Each child will receive a general developmental assessment to support individualized learning and promote continuous growth. Our curriculum focuses on building strong foundational academic skills through hands-on, age-appropriate activities. It emphasizes active learning, encouraging children to engage in meaningful experiences, make decisions and reflect on their learning to become confident, independent learners.

Children will be introduced to:

- Letter recognition
- Colors and numbers
- Shapes and geometric solids
- Continents and world flags
- Name tracing and early writing skills
- Understanding birthdays and personal milestones

To support early bilingual awareness, **numbers and colors are introduced in both English and Spanish.** Learning experiences are designed to encourage exploration, language development, and confidence while supporting each child's developmental level.
